Date: Qualifier: **Saturday 11th June 2011**
Final: **Sunday 12th June 2011**

Event Centre: Recreation Centre Nesměř near Velké Meziříčí (49°18'30"N, 16°1'53'E) (Eliášova myslivna). Space for club tents, washrooms, mobile toilets, accommodation (booked only).

Registration: in the event centre, Friday 6 p.m. – 10 p.m., Saturday 9:30 - 10:45 a.m., Sunday 8:30 - 9:00 a.m.

Arrival: Since the 3-km long road leading to the Nesměř centre is very narrow with limited possibilities of giving way to oncoming cars, all competitors – especially the clubs coming by bus - are asked to plan a sufficient time reserve for their journey and the registration. (The journey from Velké Meziříčí can take up to 30 minutes)!!! Cars/buses

of the competitors who have applied for accommodation in the centre can be parked in the area itself. Drivers are asked to follow the organizers' instructions!!

Winner's time: expected according to the Czech Orienteering Association Competition Regulations for Foot Orienteering

Programme and timetable

Saturday – qualifier:

Championship categories HD16,18,20,21:

Control descriptions on maps only. Competitors are obliged to wear their start numbers on the chest, the numbers will be available at the start - self-service system. Competitors are obliged to pass through the check station at the Nesměř bridge (on the way to the start) and punch their SI cards there by 12:30 at the latest and then they are forbidden to return back over the bridge. Maps with the competitor's name and number will be handed over at the start time. Bags for competitors' sweatshirts/jackets are available at the start, their transportation to the centre ensured.

Other categories:

The start times come after the Championship categories. Control descriptions available in the centre (self-service system) as well as on the maps. Self-service map-taking on the compulsory leg before the map start.

Sunday - final:

Start 1 - Championship categories HD16,18,20,21 (final A):

Control descriptions on the maps and/or available on the self-service base in the pre-start area. Start numbers obligatory on competitors' chests, available on a self-service base in the pre-start area. Passage through the check station (500 m before the start) and punching SI cards by 12:20 at the latest, returning forbidden. Self-service map-taking on the compulsory leg before the map start. Bags for competitors' sweatshirts/jackets are available at the start, their transportation to the centre ensured.

Start 1 – categories H 16, 18, 20, 21 (finals B,C,D,E); D 18, 20, 21 (finals B,C,D); H35A,B; H40A,B:

The start times come before the Final A. Control descriptions available in the centre (self-service system) as well as on the maps. Self-service map-taking on the compulsory leg before the map start.

Start 2 – categories D 18 (finals B,C); H45, H50, H55, H60, H65, H70, H75 (A,B,C); D35, D40, D45, D50, D55, D60, D65 (A,B); P3, T5: The start times come before the Final A. Control descriptions available in the centre (self-service system) as well as on the maps. Self-service map-taking on the compulsory leg before the map start. The marked route to the start goes through the competition area. That's

why it is strictly prohibited to leave it – in such a case a competitor can be disqualified!!

Punching System: SPORTIdent for all classes; One single SI chip must not be used twice in the competition. Competitors are obliged to clear and check their SI card in the pre-start corridors. In case of a control electronic unit defect, the passage through the control must be marked onto special squares on the map. Such a map must be handed over for checking at the finish. Later protests won't be taken into account. Competitors must download their SI cards to register even in case they don't finish the race.

Training: - possible in the area before the qualifier start. Training maps available in the event centre (self-service).

First starts: Saturday 12:00, Sunday 9:30, at intervals

Time 000: Saturday 12:00, individual starts
Sunday 09:30, individual starts

Start lists: - for Saturday - available at the registration. Sunday start lists will be made public on Saturday evening on the event website, in the event centre and in the gymnasium in Velké Meziříčí. All start lists will be displayed in the event centre and at the starts.

Map key: ISOM 2000. Print: offset, Waterproof (plastic bag).
Special map symbols: - a green circle - a distinctive tree
- a brown cross - a charcoal burning ground.
Caution: No rootstocks have been included into the map!!

Compulsory legs: - from the start to the map start – red strings
- from the last control to the finish - a tape-marked route

Forbidden areas: - the whole forest area from the car park to the event centre and forests around the event centre on both banks of the Oslava river with the

exception of the training area. The qualifier area will be open after the qualifier finishes.

Handing in the maps: - at the finish until the last competitor's start time. Their distribution will be announced by the organizers.

Results: Preliminary results will be continuously updated and displayed in printed version on the information board and on the large-scale electronic LCD screen in the event centre.

Prize-giving ceremony: Sunday, at approx. 01:45 p.m., 3 best competitors in every category

Time limit: 90 minutes

Closing of the finish: - both on Saturday and Sunday - 90 minutes after the last competitor's start

Terrain: Diverse, varied terrain with irregularly scattered small rocks, boulders and stones of various sizes. In one part sharply cut valleys and grooves, in some places difficult highland ground. Rich and diverse forest vegetation with many details. A plateau. The altitude about 500 m above sea level. Arm and leg covering recommended.

Toilets, washing: In the event centre both flush and mobile toilets available. Limited number of mobile toilets at the starts both on Saturday and Sunday. Limited washing at the flush toilets. Washing in the Oslava river recommended, however the usage of soap and shampoo is forbidden (protected natural area!!).

Refreshment: In the event centre, an offer of both hot and cold meals and beverages. Drinking water at the starts on both days.

First aid: available in the event centre

Notes, restrictions: Entry to sown fields and areas bordered by tapes is strictly prohibited. *Staying overnight in the event centre except in pre-booked accommodation is absolutely prohibited!!*
Selling goods or promoting activities are subject to the event director's prior approval.
Protest fee: CZK 200,-
Competitors participate at their own risk.

Places of interest: Velké Meziříčí (the Lutheran grammar school building, a highway bridge, St. Nicholas church, the castle with the museum, the Mostišťe dam
Třebíč – UNESCO sights – Jewish Quarter, St. Procopius` Basilica.

Regulation: The competition is subject to the valid orienteering regulations. (IOF Competition Rules 2011)
